ROPES AND BRAIDED End-Use Products in Technical Textiles and Nonwovens: World Market Forecasts to 2010

Structure of the Tables

Part A consists of **10 Summary Tables**, which provide an overview of the ropes and braided products market worldwide over the period 1995-2010. The tables split total world ropes and braids consumption by individual product, application area, region, fibre type, yarn type and coating type.

Parts B to E provide a detailed analysis of **12 individual ropes and braided products** with consumption forecasts to 2010:

- Part B (4 tables) shows the consumption of each product across **8 regions** in 2002 and 2010.
- Part C (2 tables) shows each of **11 fibre types** used in the production of each rope and braided product for 2002 and 2010.
- Part D (7 tables) shows each of the **5 yarn types** used in the production of each rope and braided product in 2002 and 2010 and separately for 1995 and then for each year from 2000 to 2010
- Part E (4 tables) shows the two coating types used in the production of each rope and braided product for 2002 and 2010.
